- 12.30pm -Councillor or Mayor on communities working together
- 12.35pm - interfaith leader or leader of another faith
- 12.40pm - interfaith leader or leader of another faith
- 12.45pm - Local community group leader- Faith and Understanding
- 12.50pm - Female (Volunteer) – intro about the Mosque and its services
- 12.55pm - Break for Prayer/Exhibition
- 1.15pm - Tour, followed by tours every 30 minutes. Female as well as male guides. Tour will discuss basics of Islam as well as features of Mosque.
